

# Family Presentation

## **Overview:**

In this fun and exciting lesson, the students, with the help of the teacher, create a family PowerPoint presentation. If your site has a lab, students will learn how to make a 3-6 slide presentation introducing their family. If your site does not have a lab, you will learn how to create a class family presentation, with students responsible for one slide introducing their family. Students will be responsible for either, using a digital camera to take pictures of their family, or bringing in pictures of their family to be scanned into the computer. The students will also be responsible for writing one paragraph per slide making sure to go through the writing process including proofreading and editing for each one. This lesson requires that the students prepare and plan before ever going on the computer.
